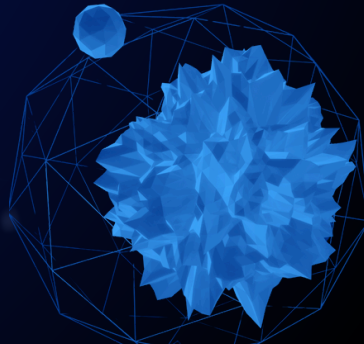

ABOUT CODATHON

Codathon is a two-day flagship coding and problem-solving competition designed to challenge, inspire, and elevate participants across all skill levels—from beginners to advanced competitive programmers, with an **expected footfall of 500+ participants**.

The event provides a competitive yet inclusive environment, enabling students to assess their technical proficiency, logical reasoning, and coding efficiency under real-world constraints.

Who Can Participate?

- Undergraduate students from all academic years.
- Beginners testing their programming fundamentals.
- Intermediate developers enhancing logic and efficiency.
- Advanced coders sharpening DSA and optimization skills.

EVENT STRUCTURE

Event Structure

Codathon is structured into three progressive rounds, each targeting a different skill set:

Round 1: MCQ Based

Conceptual and logic-based questions Tests fundamentals, aptitude, and problem understanding.

Round 2: Basic Coding

Consists of 10 easy coding questions designed to test participants' understanding of basic programming concepts.

Round 3: Intermediate Coding

5 coding questions of moderate difficulty, focusing on improved problem-solving skills.

Round 4: Advanced Coding

5 challenging coding questions to check participants' ability to handle complex logic.

Evaluation Criteria

Participants are evaluated on:

- Accuracy of solutions
- Logical approach & strategy
- Code efficiency & optimization
- Time management

All submissions are assessed using predefined, transparent benchmarks to ensure fairness and credibility.
